The doors and windows open up, the streets and the square fill up, all take place in this orchestra made of sounds, words, gestures and steps. This one, which belongs to everyone, they call **ORQUESTRA DO BAIRRO (Neighbourhood** Orchestra). The Orquestra do Bairro is formed by six musicians, from various musical and artistic training backgrounds. Created in 2022 within the scope of the Project BAIRROCELEIROS, by initiative and challenge of PédeXumbo, it takes on the role of unconventional local orchestra, creating its performance based on the fusion of different sounds and dances, influenced by what's around in here, from our neighbourhood, from the Portuguese Songbook, but also impacted by an European influence, often passed on from people to people, neighbours to neighbours, throughout several generations...

Um, Dois, Trio (One, Two, Trio) is the name of the new dancing creation of PédeXumbo, featuring Sérgio Galante on the chordophones, Filipa Jaques on voices and electronics, and Mariana Correia on voice, cello and timbrel. They create unique sounds based on the traditional songbook, inspired by what's inside and beyond its physical and imaginary borders. In this concert- dance for parents and children anything can happen: the lemon-balm will go up the river towards the ocean and the fish will cross the sea like birds, in a universe where everyone fits and can dance together.



The Baile das Histórias (The Tale Dance) is a dance with a Caller (baile mandado) made up of mostly portuguese repertoire, with live interpretation and original musical arrangements. Based on the universe of the portuguese painter Paula Rego, it presents itself as a dance with a scenic alignment given by circle dances, tales and rigmaroles told and danced, old sayings and children's nursery rhymes of today.

When choosing a character, Animal or Man, the audience is also choosing a character to take part in the big circle and, thus, assuming, with the help of clothing props, a body with a purpose in the social game at the dance

**SEARA** is a dialogue between tradition and present-day, a place of listening between two parallel territories which symbolize two different rhythms of personification of culture, through the body and expression of the aesthetic awareness. As a duet, between dance and music, this creation focus its sound and choreographic research on the popular tradition of the moda das Saias, a dance performed mostly by the people of the Alto Alentejo region, and on other traditional dances, on the activities once uttered on the grain fields and on the research for visual and sound landscapes of the Alentejo plains, on the meanings and places tradition can occupy today or on its absence, but also on the current mankind landscapes, where everything seems to be misplaced, the seasons, the weather, the harvests, the emotions and the mess. The return to places which call upon sensations and meanings of origin and beginning. Perhaps, here is where we might have to return to.



Workshops adjusted to different audiences, with a repertoire filed with world, european, portuguese and Alentejo dances.

In the **world dances** workshops, we are taken in a journey through rhythms and choreographies going from the dances from Polynesia to the warm rhythms of Africa or Central America.

The **european dances** workshop explores the traditional repertoire of the folk dances, in which we learn dances from France, Ireland, Great-Britain, Italy, Greece, Spain, Baltic Countries, among others.

The **portuguese dance** instructor covers the repertoire from north to south, making participants to dance in a circle, in pairs and square dancing.

On the other hand, the **Alentejo dances** workshop focus on arquinhos (a circle dance), danças de mastro (mast and ribbon dance), modas (singing musics) and valsas mandadas (waltz with a caller).



## ZAMPADANÇAS

To put asleep or sooth the baby, we use lullables and sounds, accompanied by rhythmic movements and rigmaroles, made-up many generations ago and work as the first contact of the child with traditional music and dance.

The way we put our babies to sleep in Portugal is different from the other cultures. For instance, in Japan little strokes in the baby's back are used and in Vietnam, the hammock is gently rocked. In the African tradition, usually, the children are strongly hugged and rocked, in a fast pace, to sooth them when crying.

Ninananas involves a small journey through the sweet melodies which rock the children from several cultures - by listening and singing, performing the movements which ties us to our baby and other babies around the world who, though different, also evoke endless love.


## Unique Musical Instruments

PédeXumbo has been devoting itself, since 1998, to the promotion of traditional music and dance. A professional team is dedicated to recovering these cultural activities, through records, co-productions, artistic creation, research, trainers training and informal teaching, appropriate for all ages.

More than immortalizing relics, PédeXumbo is set to revive social habits of experiencing music, recreating traditional dances, engaged by the new generations who are going back to the ancient ways for inspiration. At Espaço Celeiros, in Évora, regular dance and music workshops are programmed, as well as concerts, dances and gatherings for all age ratings. We put together festivals around the country, of which Andanças is the most well-known.

We organize regular dance classes within the schools and kindergartens, community projects of artistic education and promote training sessions which explore several aspects of the traditional dances. Besides having international partners, it maintains a groundbreaking role within the artistic creation of new dance formats, exploring concepts like social dancing, interactivity, ritual, creativity, contemporaneity, tradition. It sets up an area of ethnochoreology research, having edited books, brochures and documentaries.
